# NAGA First Swing and Learn to Golf Clinic

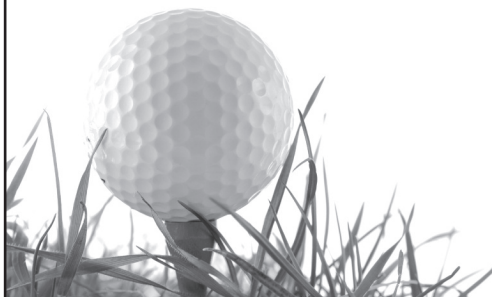

This free program will teach individuals with disabilities the basics of golf as well as teach therapists and golf professionals how to instruct people in adaptive golf techniques. If you have always wanted to take a swing at the game of golf, join other therapists and individuals with disabilities from the community at our Learn to Golf Clinic.

## This hands-on clinic will:

- Introduce and review basic golf techniques to improve functional skills, such as range of motion and balance.
- Provide an opportunity to experience the SoloRider Golf Cart with a swivel seat. This technology allows people with disabilities access to golf from a sitting or standing position with support from the cart.
- Introduce special equipment, such as adaptive golf clubs and accessories.
